- 2. Do not allow Axalta™ Silicone Remover 200 to dry on the surface.
- 3. Allow cleaned surfaces to dry completely before recoating.
- 4. Heavily soiled areas need to be cleaned more than once.
- This product is not suitable for cleaning spray guns or tools or removing release agents from raw plastic parts.
- 6. Axalta™ Silicone Remover 210 Water or Axalta™ Silicone Remover 220 Low VOC must be used for final cleaning prior to use of any waterborne products.

FIELD OF APPLICATION

For cleaning surfaces prior to applying primers, surfacers, or top coats.

PROCEDURE

- Wash vehicle and/or part with soap and water and thoroughly dry
- Apply Axalta[™] Silicone Remover 200 with a spray bottle or clean cloth.
- Wipe dry with a clean cloth before Axalta™ Silicone Remover 200 evaporates.
